

TABLE TENNIS COMPETITION RULES 8th CHILDREN OF ASIA INTERNATIONAL SPORTS GAMES

1. General provisions

- 1.1. Dates of conducting of the 8th Children of Asia International Sports Games – June 25 – July 7, 2024.
Arrivals – June 25, 2024, Departures – July 7, 2024.
- 1.2. Dates of conducting of Table Tennis competitions – June 25 – June 30, 2024.
- 1.3. Competition venue: Sakha Republic (Yakutia), Yakutsk (Sulus Fitness and Health Complex)

2. Extract from the Regulations of the Games

Team composition: 7 people, including:

boys - 2 people, girls - 2 people

coaches and other specialists - no more than 2 people

team representative - 1 person

Age of participants - under 16 years old (01.01.2009-31.12.2010)

Individual competitions will be held in the following program types:

singles (boys)

singles (girls)

doubles (boys)

doubles (girls)

mixed doubles

For the united teams from foreign countries additional 1 referee is allowed.

3. Technical regulations of the Games

- 3.1. Membership of the participants in the united teams from federal districts and regions of the Russian Federation is determined by their registration in respective region (federal district) or participation may be granted subject to the availability of the confirming documents (extract from the order of admission) on membership in physical culture and sports organization of region (federal district) represented, issued no later than September 1, 2023.
- 3.2. Membership of the participants in the united teams from foreign countries is determined in accordance with their citizenship.

- 3.3. Technical application submitted by the team representatives in Russian and English, representatives of foreign teams are allowed to submit in English.
- 3.4. Team representatives submit Nominal application (original) and documents specified in the Games Regulations to the Credentials Committee upon arrival.

4. Competition management

- 4.1. The 8th Children of Asia International Sports Games Organizing Committee performs overall guidance in preparation and holding of the competition.
- 4.2. The direct direct conduct of the competition is entrusted to the Chief Referee Board:
Technical Director of the competition - Ian Zubar
Chief Referee of the competition - Aleksandr Aleksandrov
Chief Secretary of the competition - Aleksandra Sofronova, SSWC.
- 4.3. Hosting organizations are obliged to ensure that competitions are held in accordance with the legislation of the Russian Federation insofar as they do not contradict international treaties of the Russian Federation, with the current rules and technical regulations of holding Table tennis competition.

5. General safety requirements

- 5.1. The safety of participants and spectators is ensured in accordance with the requirements of the Safety Rules for conduct of official sports competitions, approved by Decree of the Government of the Russian Federation dated April 18, 2014 No. 353, as well as the requirements of the rules for sports included in the Games program.
- 5.2. The Games are held at sports facilities included in the All-Russian Register of Sports Facilities in accordance with Federal Law No. 329-FZ dated December 4, 2007 "On Physical Culture and Sports in the Russian Federation", in presence of acts of readiness of the sports facility for holding events approved in the established order.

6. General requirements for medical support

- 6.1. The provision of emergency medical care is carried out in accordance with the order of the Ministry of Health of Russia dated October 23, 2020 No. 1144n "On approval of the procedure for organizing the provision of medical care to persons involved in physical culture and sports (including in the preparation and conduct of physical culture and sports events), including the procedure for medical examination of persons wishing to undergo sports training,

- engage in physical culture and sports in organizations and (or) fulfill the test standards (tests) of the All-Russian physical culture and sports complex "Ready for Labor and Defense" (TRP) and the forms of medical reports on admission to participate in physical culture and sports events.
- 6.2. Responsible for organizing medical support is Chief Doctor of the competition, appointed by order of the Ministry of Health of the Sakha Republic (Yakutia).
- 6.3. In order to ensure appropriate medical support during the competitions Organizing Committee provides:
 general medical team or anesthesiology and resuscitation medical team in ambulance depending on sports competitions near the sports venue to ensure minimum time to hospitalization;
 presence of medical personnel during competitions and official trainings.
- 6.4. During competitions and official training, medical personnel must be in the sports facility in the field of view of the referees, in places determined by the Chief Referee. Medical team arrives at sports venue 1 hour before the start of the competitions and must inform the Chief Referee about their arrival.

Competition schedule is subject to change by the Chief Referee of the competition in agreement with the Chief Referee Board of the Games.

8. Conditions of revealing results

The competitions are held in the following disciplines: singles, doubles, and mixed doubles. In doubles and mixed doubles competitions, the competition is a single elimination format after one loss to the majority of 5 games (up to 3 games won). Third place is not awarded. A pair can only be formed from athletes of the same team.

Singles competitions are conducted as follows: Qualification competitions - 8 groups of 4-6 participants. Matches within groups are played in a round robin format, in one round. Athletes who take 1st and 2nd place in their groups advance to the final competitions.

Final competitions are conducted in a single elimination format after one loss. Third place is not awarded. Matches in the qualification competitions for singles and in all types of doubles competitions are played to a majority of 5 games (up to 3 games won).

Matches in the final competitions in singles are played to a majority of 7 games (up to 4 games won).

9. Awarding

The awards ceremony takes place after the end of the final matches. The order and location of the award ceremonies (flower ceremony, medal award) are determined by the Organizing Committee.
