

VOLLEYBALL COMPETITION RULES 8th CHILDREN OF ASIA INTERNATIONAL SPORTS GAMES

1. General provisions

- 1.1. Dates of conducting of the 8th Children of Asia International Sports Games – June 25 – July 7, 2024.
Arrivals – June 25, 2024, Departures – July 7, 2024.
- 1.2. Dates of conducting of Volleyball competitions – June 28 – July 6, 2024.
- 1.3. Competition venue: Sakha Republic (Yakutia), Yakutsk (Chypchaal Sports Complex, Sterkh Sports Complex)

2. Extract from the Regulations of the Games

Team composition - 31 persons, including:

boys - 12 persons

girls - 12 persons

coaches and other specialists - no more than 6 people

team representative - 1 person

Age of participants: 15-16 years (01.01.2008-31.12.2009)

For the united teams from foreign countries additional 1 referee is allowed.

3. Technical regulations of the Games

- 3.1. Competitions are held according to the Volleyball Rules, approved by order of the Ministry of Sports of the Russian Federation No. 261 dated March 29, 2022, as amended on November 16, 2023 No. 809.
- 3.2. Teams are required to have two sets of uniforms (light and dark), with numbers according to the rules, numbered from 1 to 20.
- 3.3. Games are played with Mikasa V200W balls, warm-up and game balls are provided by the organizers.
- 3.4. Membership of the participants in the united teams from federal districts and regions of the Russian Federation is determined by their registration in respective region (federal district) or participation may be granted subject to the availability of the confirming documents (extract from the order of admission) on membership in physical culture and sports organization of region (federal district) represented, issued no later than September 1, 2023.

- 3.5. Membership of the participants in the united teams from foreign countries is determined in accordance with their citizenship.
- 3.6. The basis for admission of participants is a nominal application for participation in sports competitions, signed by a sports medicine doctor or an authorized representative of a medical organization, having information about the athletes undergoing the medical check, with an explanation of the name, patronymic (if any) and certified by the seal of a medical organization licensed to carry out medical activities involving work (services) in physical therapy and sports medicine.
- 3.7. Technical applications (sample form in the Regulations) are submitted by a team representative in Russian and English; foreign teams can only submit in English.
- 3.8. Team representatives submit Nominal application (original) and documents specified in the Games Regulations to the Credentials Committee upon arrival.
- 3.9. The teams are divided into two groups according to the draw; the schedule is compiled according to Berger table; in groups, games are played in a round robin format; teams that took 1st place in one group play in the semi-finals with the team that took 2nd place in another group; The winners of the semi-finals play for 1st place, teams that lost the game play for 3rd place. Teams that took 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th places will play for 5th, 7th, 9th, 11th places.
- 2 points are given for a victory, for a loss - 1 point, for a no-show - 0 points (0:25; 0:25; 0:25). If two or more teams are tied on the number of points gained, they will be ranked in the following order:
- a) points ratio in all matches;
 - b) sets ratio in all matches;
 - c) the number of victories in matches between tied teams;
 - d) sets ratio in matches between tied teams;
 - e) points ratio in matches between tied teams.
- If the tie has broken between one or more teams using above-mentioned order, and the rest of the teams remain tied than these teams will be ranked according to terms "a", "b", "c" and etc.
- Volleyball matches are made up of 5 sets and up to three victories. Games are played up to 25 points with a margin of 2 points; 5th set - up to 15 points with a margin of 2 points.

4. Competition management

- 4.1. The 8th Children of Asia International Sports Games Organizing Committee performs overall guidance in preparation and holding of the competition.
- 4.2. The direct conduct of the competition is entrusted to the Chief Referee Board:

Technical Director of the competition – Ivan Grishkin
Chief Referee of the competition – Sergei Senichenko
Chief Secretary of the competition – Evgeniy Popov.

- 4.3. Hosting organizations are obliged to ensure that competitions are held in accordance with the legislation of the Russian Federation insofar as they do not contradict international treaties of the Russian Federation, with the current rules and technical regulations of holding Volleyball competition.

5. General safety requirements

- 5.1. The safety of participants and spectators is ensured in accordance with the requirements of the Safety Rules for conduct of official sports competitions, approved by Decree of the Government of the Russian Federation dated April 18, 2014 No. 353, as well as the requirements of the rules for sports included in the Games program.
- 5.2. The Games are held at sports facilities included in the All-Russian Register of Sports Facilities in accordance with Federal Law No. 329-FZ dated December 4, 2007 “On Physical Culture and Sports in the Russian Federation”, in presence of acts of readiness of the sports facility for holding events approved in the established order.

6. General requirements for medical support

- 6.1. The provision of emergency medical care is carried out in accordance with the order of the Ministry of Health of Russia dated October 23, 2020 No. 1144n “On approval of the procedure for organizing the provision of medical care to persons involved in physical culture and sports (including in the preparation and conduct of physical culture and sports events), including the procedure for medical examination of persons wishing to undergo sports training, engage in physical culture and sports in organizations and (or) fulfill the test standards (tests) of the All-Russian physical culture and sports complex "Ready for Labor and Defense" (TRP) and the forms of medical reports on admission to participate in physical culture and sports events.
- 6.2. Responsible for organizing medical support is Chief Doctor of the competition, appointed by order of the Ministry of Health of the Sakha Republic (Yakutia).
- 6.3. In order to ensure appropriate medical support during the competitions Organizing Committee provides:

- 6.4. general medical team or anesthesiology and resuscitation medical team in ambulance depending on sports competitions near the sports venue to ensure minimum time to hospitalization;
- 6.5. presence of medical personnel during competitions and official trainings.
- 6.6. During competitions and official training, medical personnel must be in the sports facility in the field of view of the referees, in places determined by the Chief Referee. Medical team arrives at sports venue 1 hour before the start of the competitions and must inform the Chief Referee about their arrival.
