

CHESS COMPETITION RULES 8th CHILDREN OF ASIA INTERNATIONAL SPORTS GAMES

1. General provisions

- 1.1. Dates of conducting of the 8th Children of Asia International Sports Games – June 25 – July 7, 2024.
Arrivals – June 25, 2024, Departures – July 7, 2024.
- 1.2. Dates of conducting of Chess competition – June 26 – July 4, 2024.
- 1.3. Competition venue: Sakha Republic (Yakutia), Yakutsk (NEFU Natural Sciences Building)

2. Extract from the Regulations of the Games

Team composition – 7 persons, including:

boys – 2 persons

girls – 2 persons

coaches and other specialists – no more than 2 persons.

team representative – 1 person

Age of participants: 16 years and younger (01.01.2008 and younger).

Competitions are individual (separately among boys and girls) in Swiss system in 9 rounds.

Time control: 1 hour 30 minutes for each participant until the end of the game with an addition of 30 seconds for each move starting from the first.

The winners are determined by the highest number of points scored. In case of equality of points, the places are determined by the truncated Buchholz coefficient, then by the Buchholz coefficient, then by personal meeting, in case of equality of all three indicators, the decisive game is played ("Armageddon") with a time control of 5 minutes for white and 4 minutes for black with the addition of 3 seconds for move, starting from the 61st move for each participant. The color of the pieces is chosen by the athlete who draws lots. In case of a tie, the winner is the participant who played with black pieces.

According to the Regulations, the maximum number of participants from the Far Eastern, Siberian, Ural Federal Districts, the second team of the Sakha Republic (Yakutia) is 1 boy, 1 girl, from the teams of Bashkortostan, Moscow 1 boy, 1 girl, coaches (other specialists) no more than 1 person.

3. Technical regulations of the Games

- 3.1. Membership of the participants in the united teams from federal districts and regions of the Russian Federation is determined by their registration in respective region (federal district) or participation may be granted subject to the availability of the confirming documents (extract from the order of admission) on membership in physical culture and sports organization of region (federal district) represented, issued no later than September 1, 2023.
- 3.2. Membership of the participants in the united teams from foreign countries is determined in accordance with their citizenship.
- 3.3. Technical application submitted by the team representatives in Russian and English, representatives of foreign teams are allowed to submit in English.
- 3.4. Team representatives submit Nominal application (original) and documents specified in the Games Regulations to the Credentials Committee upon arrival.

4. Competition management

- 4.1. The 8th Children of Asia International Sports Games Organizing Committee performs overall guidance in preparation and holding of the competition.
- 4.2. The direct direct conduct of the competition is entrusted to the Chief Referee Board:
Chief Referee of the competition – Mikhail Kryukov
Chief Secretary of the competition – Konstantin Kaliev
- 4.3. Hosting organizations are obliged to ensure that competitions are held in accordance with the legislation of the Russian Federation insofar as they do not contradict international treaties of the Russian Federation, with the current rules and technical regulations of holding Chess competition.

5. General safety requirements

- 5.1. The safety of participants and spectators is ensured in accordance with the requirements of the Safety Rules for conduct of official sports competitions, approved by Decree of the Government of the Russian Federation dated April 18, 2014 No. 353, as well as the requirements of the rules for sports included in the Games program.
- 5.2. The Games are held at sports facilities included in the All-Russian Register of Sports Facilities in accordance with Federal Law No. 329-FZ dated December 4, 2007 “On Physical Culture and Sports in the Russian Federation”, in presence of acts of readiness of the sports facility for holding events approved in the established order.

6. General requirements for medical support

- 6.1. The provision of emergency medical care is carried out in accordance with the order of the Ministry of Health of Russia dated October 23, 2020 No. 1144n "On approval of the procedure for organizing the provision of medical care to persons involved in physical culture and sports (including in the preparation and conduct of physical culture and sports events), including the procedure for medical examination of persons wishing to undergo sports training, engage in physical culture and sports in organizations and (or) fulfill the test standards (tests) of the All-Russian physical culture and sports complex "Ready for Labor and Defense" (TRP) and the forms of medical reports on admission to participate in physical culture and sports events.
- 6.2. Responsible for organizing medical support is Chief Doctor of the competition, appointed by order of the Ministry of Health of the Sakha Republic (Yakutia).
- 6.3. In order to ensure appropriate medical support during the competitions Organizing Committee provides:
 - general medical team or anesthesiology and resuscitation medical team in ambulance depending on sports competitions near the sports venue to ensure minimum time to hospitalization;
 - presence of medical personnel during competitions and official trainings.
- 6.4. During competitions and official training, medical personnel must be in the sports facility in the field of view of the referees, in places determined by the Chief Referee. Medical team arrives at sports venue 1 hour before the start of the competitions and must inform the Chief Referee about their arrival.
