SAKHA REPUBLIC (YAKUTIA)



Yakutia is the largest administrative-territorial unit in the world and the largest region of the Russian Federation on a territory of 3,084,000 km². Yakutsk, the capital of the Republic, is the largest city located on permafrost.

CLIMATE




Yakutsk is located in a flat area, in the valley of the Lena River. The climate in the city is sharply continental, characterized by long winters and short summers.

Summer in Yakutsk is characterized by hot weather and relatively low rainfall.

The most favorable time for outdoor activities is from late June to early August.

The average annual air temperature in summer is +20°C.





HOW TO REACH





Platon Oyunsky Yakutsk International Airport is the air gate of the Sakha Republic (Yakutia).

The airport is 15 min. drive from the city center. Yakutsk Airport is a modern terminal that meets the international requirements of class "C" in terms of comfort and safety.

The airfield of the Yakutsk airport allows medium and longhaul aircraft to be based and has the necessary capabilities to service aircraft of all types and modifications.

Yakutsk can be reached by direct flights from the following Russian cities - Moscow, Novosibirsk, Irkutsk, Khabarovsk and Vladivostok.

The proximity of one of the largest transport hubs - Harbin Airport - allows passengers to comfortably reach the host city from anywhere in Asia.

Organizing Committee will provide assisstance in finding convenient flight routes for united teams.



ACCOMMODATION



Athletes Village

Organizing Committee provides accommodation for all participants of the Games.
Athletes Village traditionally will be located on North-Eastern Federal University campus.
NEFU residential buildings are able to accommodate simultaneously 6000 people.
Access to Athletes Village will be through checkpoints subject to the availability of accreditation card with appropriate clearance level.

Accommodation

Athletes Village will be ready to accommodate 3,000 athletes and team members. There is a medical hospital and medical aid posts in every residential building. Medical service will be available 24 hours. Residential buildings have everything necessary for teams to live, including laundries, ironing, storage rooms, Wi-Fi.







MEALS



Organizing Committee provides meals for all participants of the Games.

Athletes Village will offer 3 meals a day with an increased calorie content in accordance with the specific diet of participating countries.

Menu will include the following cuisines:

- national cuisine of the host country of the Games;
- European/Mediterranean cuisine;
- Asian cuisine.

Catering facilities for participants and representatives of sports delegations will be located in the Athletes Village and at sports facilities.

Food points for honored guests, organizers and spectators will be located in sports venues.


Organizing Committee provides welcome and see-off services at Yakutsk International Airport, as well as transfer to accommodation facilities and back.


During the Games, the host city will offer services on shuttle buses along convenient routes for both sports and cultural events.


Travel time between Athletes Village and competition venues will be no more than 10-15 min.

Transfer of participants will be organized by 70 environment friendly buses. The buses are equipped with an air-conditioning system, a kneeling system, which provides convenient boarding and disembarking for all categories of passengers.
